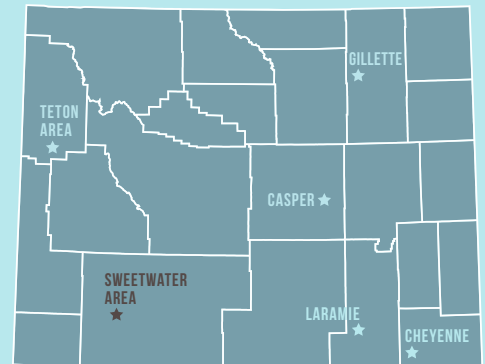
ABOVE AND BEYOND
