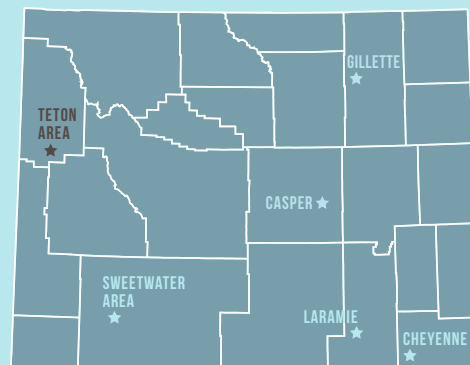


TEAM SPIRIT
