MAKING THE LEAP TO SELF-SUFFICIENCY

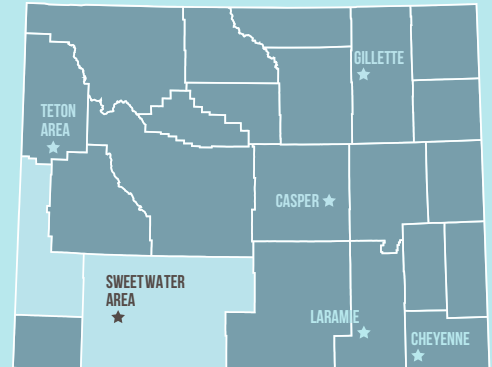
