THE ROAD TO STABILITY

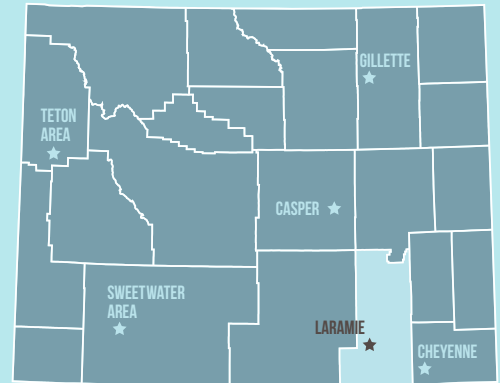
