A NEW PATH FORWARD

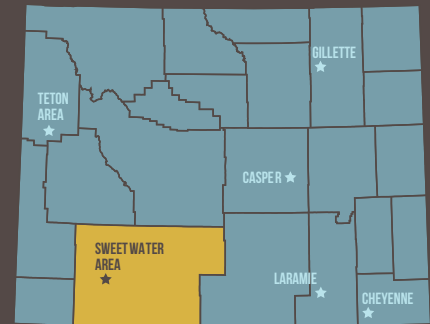
“There were certain words we heard again and again from moms at the end of this program, especially *strong, independent and empowered*. They learned that they really do have choices in life and can take back control over their futures.
