"Climb has been a truly amazing experience. It has given me my life back and given me the tools I need to provide for my son."

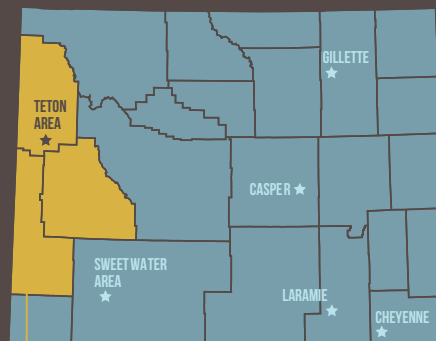
