### A DRIVE TO GET AHEAD IN LIFE

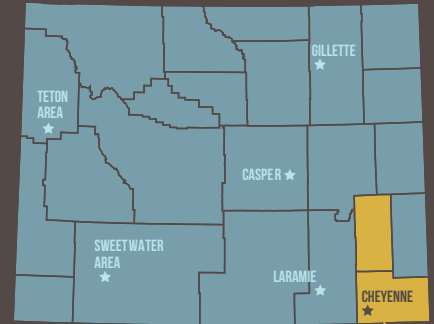
