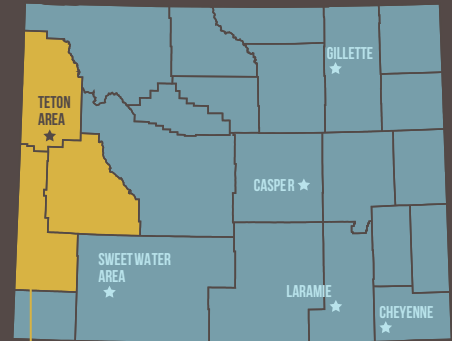
A NEW DIRECTION IN LIFE
