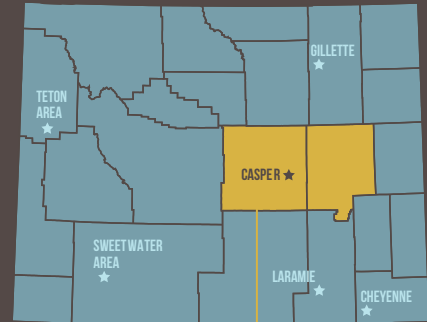
### BUILDING A SUPPORT NETWORK
